With so many new printers and multifunction devices coming out, it is hard to know which to purchase. A lot of the manufactures have websites with tools to help you figure out the upgrade to your current equipment. You just have to let them know what you currently have and they will tell you the new equivalent. On some sites you can compare different models to see which is the best fit for your situation.

Also, check out the supplies to see if they can be remanufactured so you can save some money over the cost of new.
